For Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle. Horses should be plaited. **The first three go forward to the Championship at the Royal Highland Show 2020**

All entries **MUST** be registered with the RoR and have **RACED in GB.**

There will be a prize for the highest placed veteran horse aged 15years or over.

The class will be run under the rules of RoR.

Horses to be ridden by the judge.

All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations

**Competitors must wear a hard hat with chinstrap conforming to current safety standards.**

**Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series**

**CLASS 2.**

**Best ex Racehorse.**

For thoroughbred mares and geldings 4 yrs old and over that are listed as having run under Rules of Racing. Riders must be 12 years or over on 1 January 2019. Horses should be ridden in snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle. Horses should be plaited. Horses will not be ridden by the judge and will be judged ontrainability,manners,presence, condition and turn out. Rosettes 1st to 6th. Horses placed 1st & 2nd will qualify for the Floors Castle International Horse Trials Ex Racehorse Championship to be held in the MKM arena on conclusion of class5.

### **CLASS 3.**

#### **Horse and Country Qualifier - Best Thoroughbred**

The Horse & Country Racehorses (HCR) series:: To qualify for the championships at the Grand Slam at Ingleston in September 2019, the rider and horse must be registered with HCR, you must carry your cards in the ring for signing and be placed 1st-4th (qualifications maybe passed down to 6th place). Non-members must send their qualification cards (presented by the judge), fees and register with HCR no later than 14 days after this show and before the closing date for the entries for the Grand Slam.

Horses placed 1st and 2nd will qualify for Floors Castle International Horse Trials Ex Racehorses Championship to be held in the MKM arena on conclusion of class 5. ### **Class 4.**

#### **Unaffiliated Showjumping 75cm**

For thoroughbred mares and geldings 4 yrs and over that are listed as having run under rules (either Flat or National Hunt.) Riders must be 12 years or over on 1 January 2019 to be run under BS Rules. Prizes from 1st to 6th. 1st and 2nd placed horses will qualify for the Ex Racehorses Championship to be held in the MKM arena on conclusion of class 5.

### **Class 5.**

#### **Unaffiliated Showjumping 85 cm**

For thoroughbred mares and geldings 4 yrs and over that are listed as having run under rules (either Flat or National Hunt.) Riders must be 12 years or over on 1 January 2019. To be run under BS Rules. Prizes from 1st to 6th. 1st and 2nd placed horses will qualify for the Floors Castle Horse Trials Ex Racehorses Championship to be held in the MKM arena on conclusion of Class 5

### **Class 6.**

#### **Floors Castle International Horse Trials Ex Racehorse Championship**

For horses placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in classes 2,3, 4 and 5.

Due to the recent Equine Flu Outbreak Floors Castle International Horse Trials have put a vaccination policy in place.

All classes & companion horses:

In order to be allowed to compete, ALL horses (including companion horses) must have received a primary course of flu vaccinations *(a primary course is an initial vaccination followed by a second vaccination after no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days, **with the second of these vaccinations having been given no later than 7 days prior to the start of the competition.**)*

Where the second vaccination of the primary course was completed more than 6 months prior to the start of the competition, every horse must have received continuous booster vaccinations, with the FIRST booster vaccine having been given between 150 and 215 days after the second vaccine of the primary course, and **EVERY** subsequent booster having being given within 1 year of the previous booster *(for example a horse vaccinated on 21/2/16 must have received its next booster on or before 21/02/17)*. ***Please note that in addition to this, EVERY horse that is to be stabled at Kelso racecourse, must have received a vaccination WITHIN SIX MONTHS of the date they enter the racecourse stables.***

Vaccinations given on the day of the event will **NOT** be considered as forming **ANY** part of the animal's vaccination history.

A significant number of passports will be checked and any horse found without a vaccination will be sent home.
